Attention Parents and Students: In order to receive your prom tickets this year, this agreement must be signed by both the student and the parent(s). The agreement must then be submitted to Mrs. Mack in room 155C.

### **Prom Tickets:**

- SBHS Juniors and Seniors can purchase tickets via PowerSchool eFunds until April 18<sup>th</sup>.
  - o All student fees must be paid in full prior to prom.
- Tickets will not be sold at the door on the night of prom.
- Physical tickets to the prom can be picked up in Mrs. Mack's room (155C) April 15-18<sup>th</sup>. Tickets can only be picked up if all of the following are satisfied:
  - This contract is signed by the parent and student;
  - All student fees are paid in full;
  - o The student has not been assigned OSS for any portion of Quarter 4;
  - o Completed visitor permission form for outside guests only.
- Tickets are non-refundable. No refunds will be granted if you have already purchased your ticket and are no longer eligible to attend.

## **Prom Night:**

- Prom will be held on April 19, 2024 at the Big Red Barn on Chime Bell Church Road in Aiken.
- Doors will open at 7:30PM and close at 11:00PM.
- All attendees must present a VALID PHOTO ID and TICKET to be allowed entrance.

# **Behavior and Dance Code Policy:**
