



Our mission is to provide students with a personalized and flexible learning opportunity aimed at earning a high school diploma.



PERSONALIZED PLANS

Students will be enrolled in self-paced web-based courses based on their graduation needs. Students will only be expected to work on 1 to 3 courses at a time. Students will need to have reliable internet access to complete course work.



TEACHER SUPPORT

Teachers will be available for in-person or virtual support Monday through Thursday from 4 pm to 7 pm at South Aiken High. Students will be required to attend a certain number of in-person instructional hours each week based on their personalized plan. Students are responsible for their own transportation.



ON TIME GRADUATION

Students enrolled in Summit will be able to earn more credits in one year than in a traditional high school program. This opportunity provides students with the ability to catch up on credits and graduate on time.



COUNSELOR SUPPORT

Summit's goal is to provide wrap-around services for all students. A counselor will be available to provide both social-emotional support and academic guidance.



REQUIRED CHECK-INS

Weekly, in-person check-in meetings with an assigned teacher/counselor to review student progress in the program.
