Aiken County Vocational Center was one of the first four vocational centers in the state of South Carolina and opened in opened in 1967. Aiken's trade and industrial school was created to serve students from all high schools in Aiken County. The school was renamed Aiken County Career & Technology Center in 1999 and continues to serve Aiken County High School students with vocationally based education programs throughout the district.

# **STATE & NATIONAL CREDENTIALS**

Students completing the final level of their program at the Career Center have the opportunity to earn state and national credentials which enhance their employability right out of high school. In 2016-17, ACCTC completers earned over 160 professional credentials.

Nearly 95% (94.9%) of our students achieve Technical Skill Attainment by gaining a recognized credential in their field of study.

After graduation, 97.6% of our students continue in related career fields, higher education, or the military.
