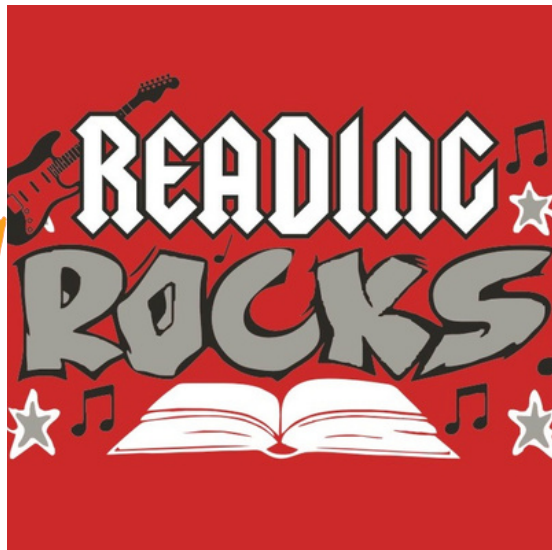


# March Newsletter

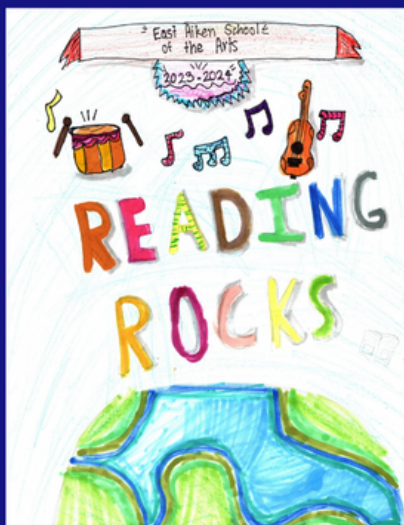

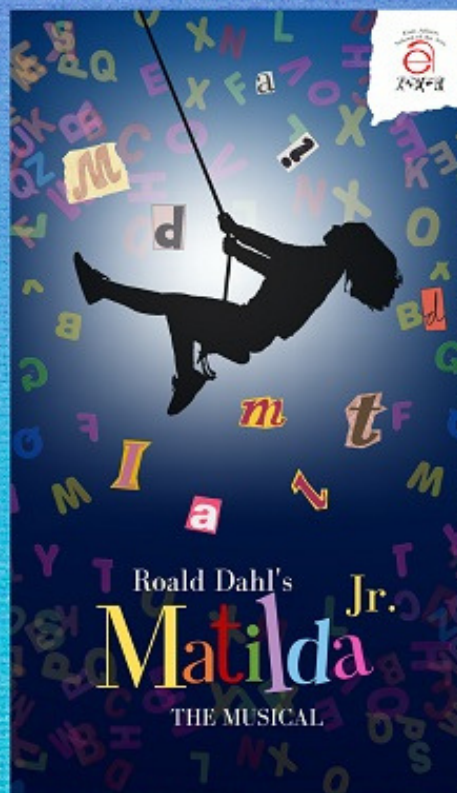

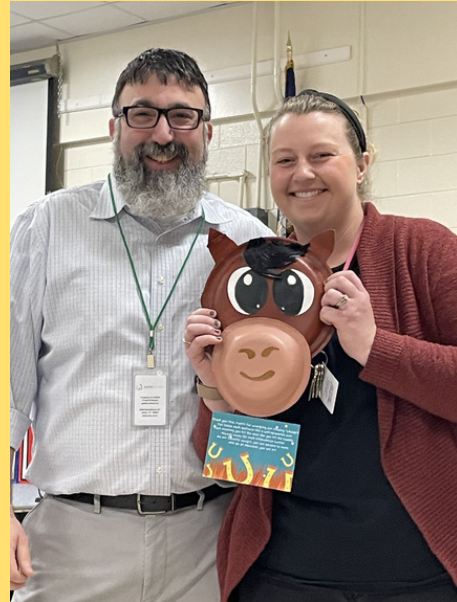
Leia Truitt was our East Aiken Citizen of the Month for January.
