## Elementary School



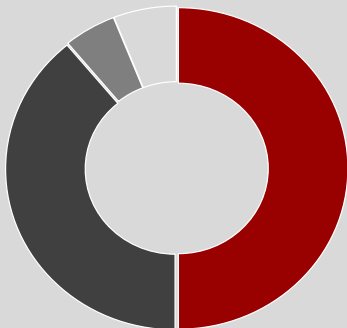
A 96,930 square foot elementary school built in 1986 in the area of southeast Aiken County between the communities of Jackson and Beech Island. It has 748 students, 52 classrooms and 2 desktop computer labs, and 1 laptop lab which classrooms utilize on a daily basis. Redcliffe is among the largest for early learners in Aiken County.



Redcliffe is heavily-focused on reading success. Our students practice their reading skills daily and are assessed by taking Reading Inventory, Benchmark tests, Fountas and Pinnell, and interventionists to support students. Teachers continue to provide a quality education which allows our students to grow and achieve academically.



Our school library has an extensive inventory with approximately 13,000 items including books, e-books, leveled book set collections and class sets. We average 29,000 in circulation each year. Our media center has 12 desktop computers, a cart of iPads and 80 iPods, document cameras, and electronic systems for checkout.

Afterschool care is available each day from 2:30-6:00 p.m. Monday-Friday right here at our school. Quest Zone is operated by the Sunshine House Child Care Center and provides on-site afterschool homework help and engaging activities for Redcliffe students.



Redcliffe hosts a number of community and special events throughout the school year, including a Veteran's Day program in partnership with Jackson Middle school's band, an African American History Program, our Seussical musical, Etiquette Luncheon and numerous parent activities.

## EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Redcliffe offers numerous afterschool activities, including a Robotics Club and competition team, a Running Club, and the Good News Club. During school hours we also sponsor a student News Team, Pawparazzi Yearbook Team, Student Council, and Library Helpers program.



## SPECIAL NEEDS

We are committed to a quality educational experience for all students, including struggling learners and those with special needs. We have 10 instructional aides, 9 reading recovery teachers, 4 reading interventionists, and a full-time nurse.



## COMMUNICATION

We utilize social media, e-flyers, an automated calling system, newsletters, regular teacher communication and teacher conferences to stay in consistent communication with the families we serve.



## SECURITY

The safety of students and staff members is our top priority. Our extensive security measures include a keyless entry system, building cameras, and automated background checks on all visitors and volunteers.
