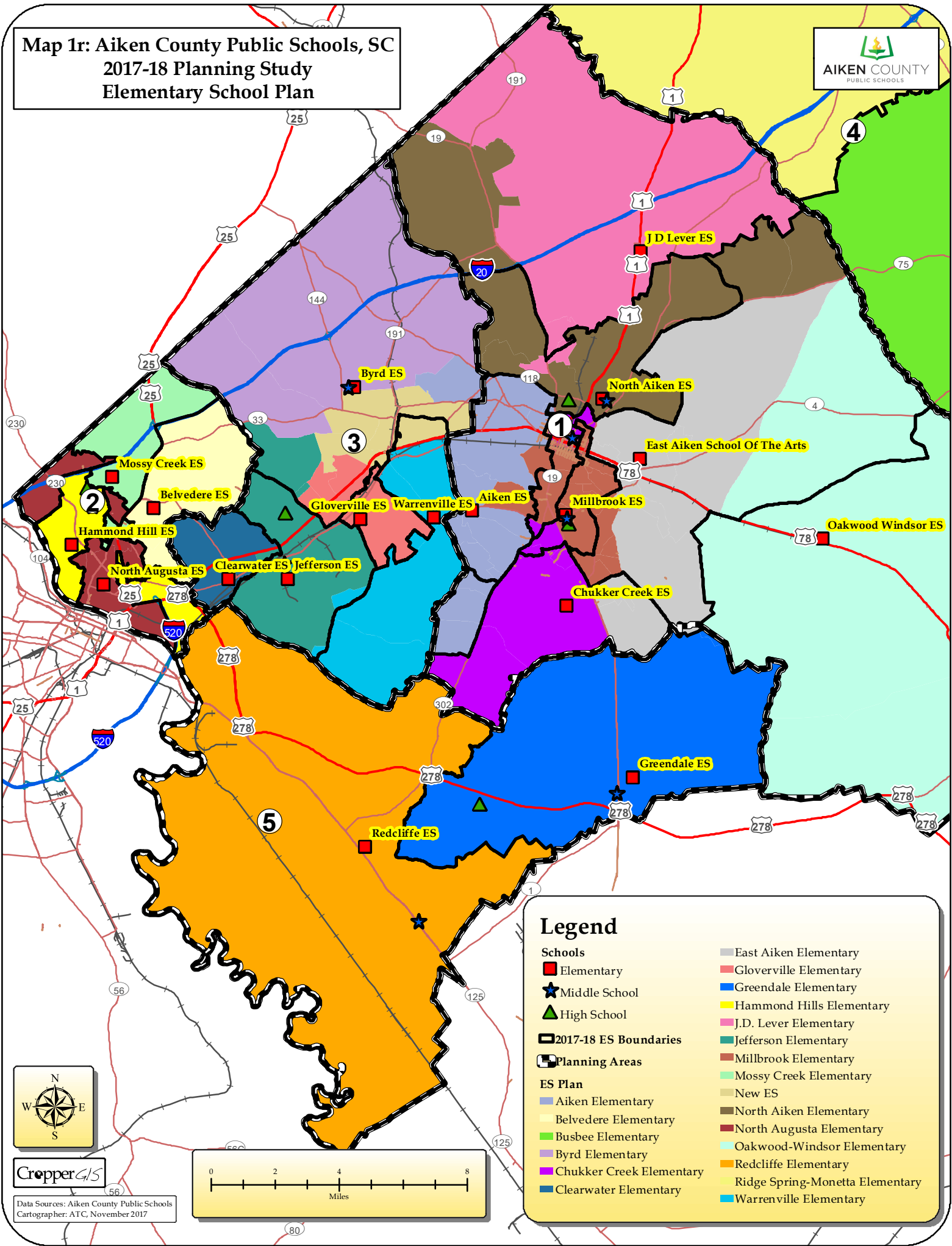

# Map 1r: Aiken County Public Schools, SC 2017-18 Planning Study Elementary School Plan



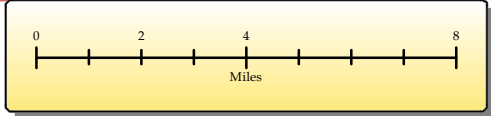

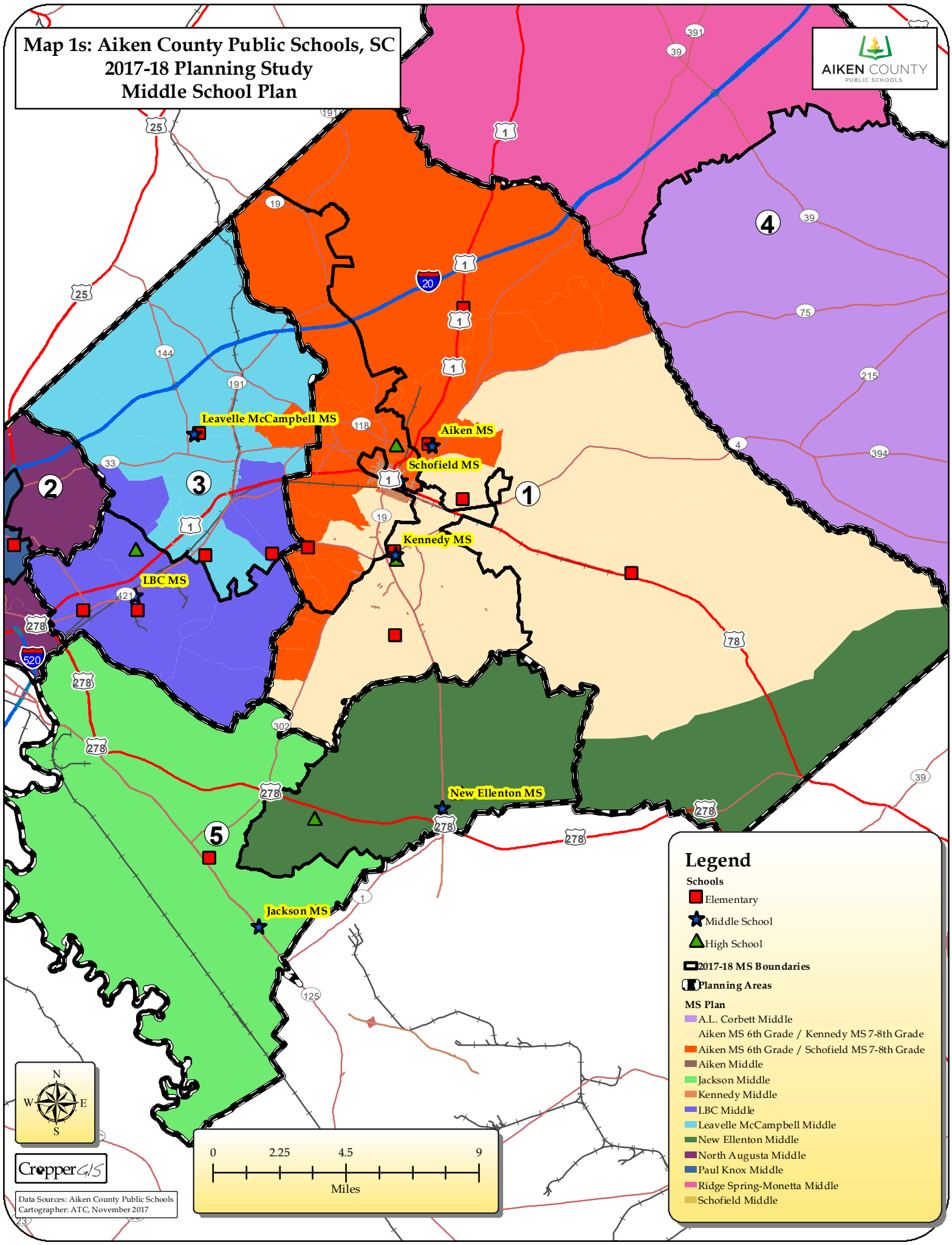

# Map 1s: Aiken County Public Schools, SC 2017-18 Planning Study Middle School Plan



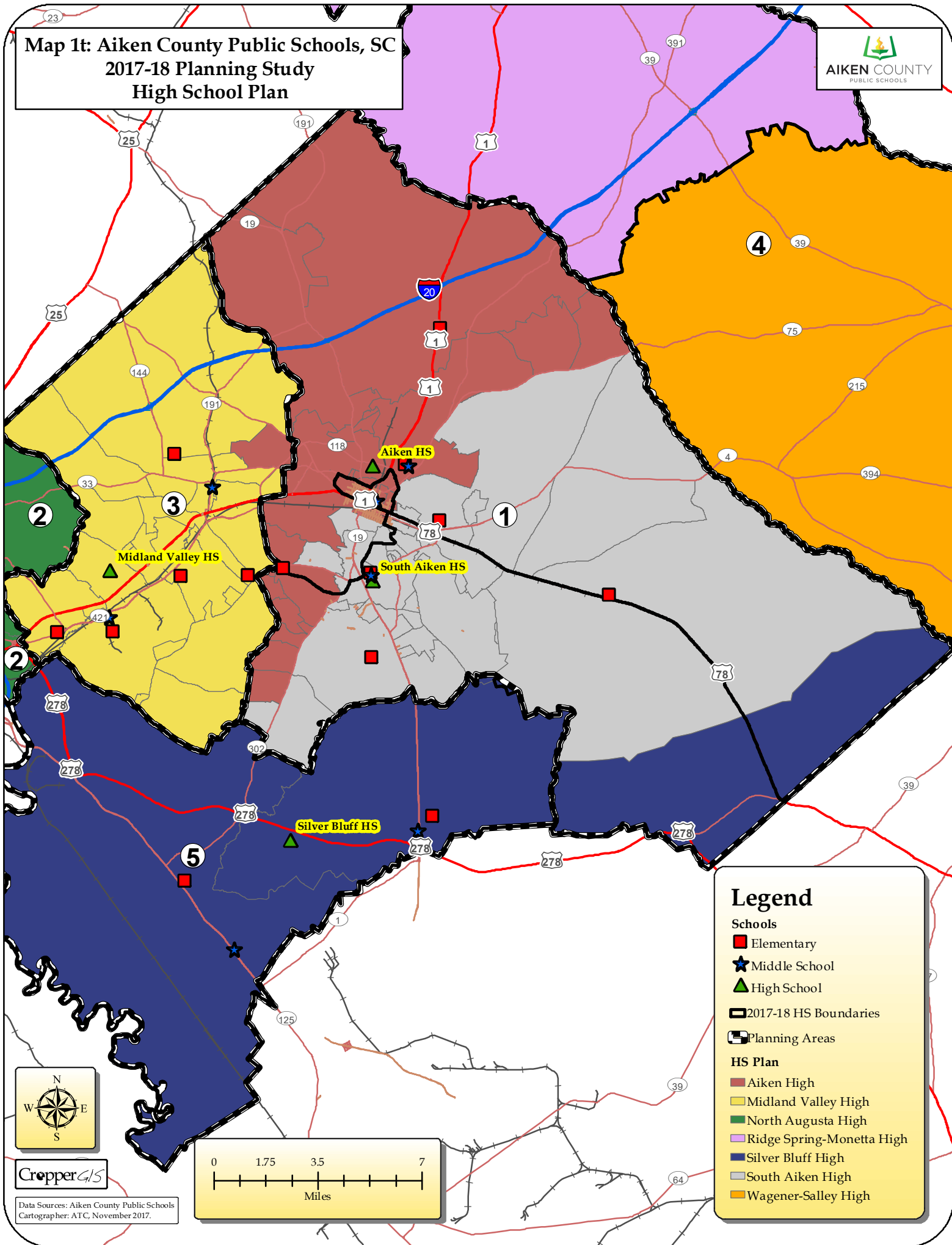
