Middle School



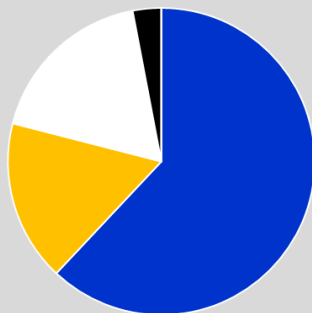
Originally built as a high school in 1952, LBC became a middle school after the construction of Midland Valley High in 1980. With 33 classrooms and 557 students, LBC is situated in one of the most tightly knit and historically relevant communities in Aiken County. Included on the LBC campus are 3 computer labs, one Synergistic STEM Lab, two ball fields, a Science Lab, Gymnasium, Auditorium, and wooded trails for scientific observations.



LBC is proud to be one of the few middle schools that offers Strings for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students. We also pride ourselves on having the highest participation percentage of any middle school in Georgia and South Carolina during the SC Day of Cyber Challenge Award. In addition, our students participate in the Academic Team, Math Counts, Lego League Robotics, and Future City annually.



Our students are consistent participants of the Combining Voices Literary Competition of Augusta's Morris Museum of Art and bring home numerous awards each year. LBC offers 6 subjects for high school credit: English I, Algebra I, Geometry, German I, Keyboarding, and Computer Apps. LBC also produces several Junior Scholars and Duke Tip recipients yearly.

Tutoring is offered by all of our teachers after school at least one day every week. We also have an Accommodations Lab to assist students needing additional help during the school day. LBC students utilize USA Test Prep online weekly for English, Math, Science and Social Studies enrichment.



Parent and community involvement is always encouraged. LBC has an active and highly-involved School Improvement Council and Parent Teacher Organization. In addition, various civic organizations and volunteer groups lend their time and talents to support our students' success.

We are committed to a quality educational experience for all students, including struggling learners and those with special needs. We have 2 self-contained classrooms, 2 Resource classroom, 3 reading recovery teachers and a full-time nurse.
