Frequently Asked Questions:

Where can I get an application for a scholarship?

Unless it specifically gives an online address, copies are found in the lobby of the Counseling Office. PLEASE do NOT take the last copy of a scholarship. Let Mrs. Tice know that copies are running low. ©

Who sends the application?

If you do not have to apply online, this one is simple. If it says "Return to Mrs. Tice" on the scholarship newsletter, you return it to me and I will print your transcript and mail it for you. If not, you mail the application on your own. Mrs. Tice is happy to mail any applications.

Are deadlines really deadlines?

Yes, yes, yes. If you miss a deadline, chances are you missed your chance at a scholarship. Please adhere strictly to deadlines.

What if a scholarship application asks for tax information?

You need to use your parent's tax info from 2022- only the first two pages. Always be sure to **white out social security numbers for safety measures.**

What if a scholarship application asks for SAT or ACT scores?

In most cases, you can download the report straight from the website (College Board for SAT, ACT.org for ACT). If you need help with this, see your counselor or Mrs. Tice.

Should I have someone proofread my essays?

YES! I would recommend your English teachers first or a counselor if your English teacher is not available.

How will I know if I won a scholarship?

Most scholarships will contact you directly, and you need to then notify Mrs. Tice. Some may be surprises on Awards Day.

Who should I ask to complete my recommendations?

Most of the time the teachers who know you best are the ones who should be writing your recommendations. Always provide them with an academic resume. Please always thank your recommenders. A thank you note is appropriate for anyone who writes you a recommendation. Also, remember to give them time (2 weeks preferably) to write a recommendation.
