Also, our First Year Teacher of the Year is Mrs. Michelle Morgan. Mrs. Morgan teaches fifth grade here at GES.



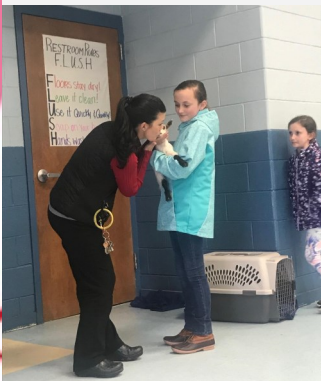

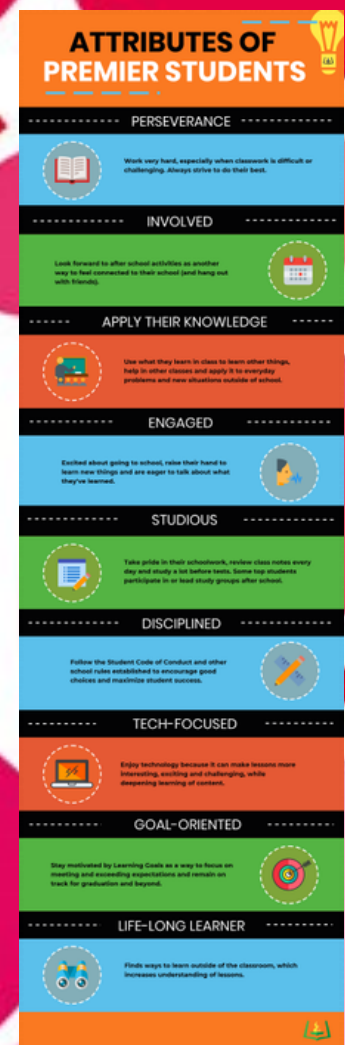
