TECH-FOCUSED



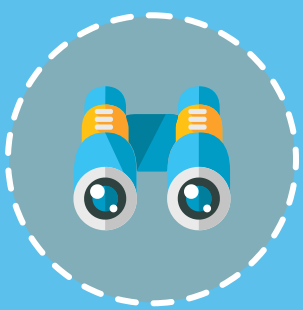
Enjoys technology because it can make lessons more interesting, exciting and challenging, while deepening learning of content.
