***As a result of COVID19, children may experience
difficulty sleeping, anxiety, depression, agitation,
trouble focusing, and changes in mood and behaviors.
Many people don't know when or how to reach out for
mental health help.***

Aiken-Barnwell Mental Health Center and Aiken County Public
School District have partnered to offer students access to
effective mental health care: psychiatric medical assessment,
individual therapy, family therapy, crisis services and more.

There are two options to begin services: through your child's
school counselor (at select schools) or through contacting
ABMHC directly.

Enroll at School:

If your child is a student at Clearwater, North Aiken, Aiken Intermediate, Leavelle McCampbell, Schofield, LBC, Paul Knox, Aiken High, South Aiken, North Augusta High, or Midland Valley please discuss our services with a school counselor as there is an ABMHC school-based therapist located at your school.

Enroll at ABMHC:

If your child is not a student at a select school, they can still receive services through ABMHC by contacting the ACCESS line at 803-508-7913.
