EOCEP English 2 Test Blueprint 2021-2022

- The EOCEP English 2 assessment consists of 55 operational items.
- Additionally, there may be embedded field-test items in the spring.
- The test is administered in two sessions: Writing and Reading.
- Item types that may appear are selected-response, evidence-based selected response (EBSR), multi-select, technology-enhanced (TE), and text dependent analysis (TDA).
- The TDA item is an essay scored with a holistic rubric. The point range of the rubric is 1 (lowest) to 4 (highest). Each student's essay is scored by two raters. The two raters' scores are averaged and weighted by 4. The maximum number of possible points is 16.
- There are three Reporting Categories: Reading Literary Text (RL), Reading Informational Text (RI), and Writing. Communication indicators will be included in the Writing Reporting Category.
- Inquiry Items are included in the total English 2 score.
