



Dual Enrollment Contract

The purpose of this contract is to give students and parents an opportunity to understand the full conditions and expectations of all students participating in dual enrollment. By signing this contract, the parent and student named below agree to the terms and conditions set forth herein to participate in the dual enrollment program at one of the schools noted below.

_____ The principal or the principal's designee must approve all coursework prior to enrolling in all college-level course work. If a student is taking a dual enrollment course to fulfill a core graduation requirement, then the principal must give approval. Acceptable courses that meet graduation requirements are on the attached page.

_____ Enrollment and acceptance decisions are at the discretion of the admitting college.

_____ Dual enrollment coursework will establish a college transcript and may affect scholarship eligibility requirements. (Visit www.che.sc.gov for South Carolina state scholarship guidelines.)

_____ The parent/guardian is responsible for all fees and tuition associated with the dual enrollment program and must contact the college with any questions or concerns.

_____ All Seniors must be enrolled in at least four (4) classes each semester. All juniors must be enrolled in at least six (6) classes each semester. If a student chooses not to participate the second semester or withdraws from dual credit classes, the student will be required to add additional classes through the virtual school or at their home high school. Dropping a class after the college deadline will result in a final grade of WF (50) on the high school transcript. Dropping a class prior to the college deadline will result in a final grade of WP (GPA neutral) on the high school transcript.

_____ The college will provide the high school with an official final grade report for the purpose of adding the final grade to the high school transcript. In the event a final numerical grade is not available, letter grades will be converted using the following South Carolina Uniform Grading Policy conversion: A=95, B=85, C=75, D=65, F=50.

_____ Every effort will be made to arrange the student schedule according to requests; however, early release, late arrival, and other requested high school courses cannot be guaranteed to correspond with dual enrollment class scheduling.
