SUBJECT:

2023 - 2024 Budget - Second/Final Reading

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In its 2023 - 2024 budget calendar, the Board scheduled presentations of the first reading of the budget for April 18, 2023, and the second & final reading for May 23, 2023. A budget hearing was held during the May 9, 2023, Board meeting.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:

The second/final reading of the Superintendent's proposed budget is presented for Board discussion and consideration. Many estimates are based on the Senate version of the 2023 – 2024 general appropriations bill. While the House and Senate versions of the budget did not differ greatly with regards to K-12 funding at the State level, the District's 2023 – 2024 State funding projections did increase for SC Department of Education update for 135th day average daily membership. The District's budget proposal has been updated for those changes.

Highlights from the General Fund budget proposal include:

- step increase for all eligible employees,
- \$2,500 increase per pay cell on the teacher, NJROTC, nurse, OT/PT, and psychologist pay scales,
- bus driver pay scale increases in accordance with State requirements for 2023 2024.
- a 3% cost of living adjustment for all other pay scales, including supplements,
- the addition of one step at the top of the teacher and other pay scales,
- the creation of an Assistant Director of Facilities position.
- the creation of a 2nd Hearing Officer position based on feedback from the May 2, 2023, special called meeting,
- one-time, \$1,000 bonuses for employees paid from scales not impacted by the January 24, 2023, bonus approval,
- \$100,000 to fund a salary study,
- a one percentage point increase in employer retirement contributions, from 23.81% to 24.81%,
- a 3.7% increase in employer health premiums, effective January 1, 2024,
- the "roll-up" of soon-to-be-eliminated State funds and their related expenditures into the General Fund,
- school staffing allocations reflective of elementary class-size caps and high school block scheduling,

- the creation of positions necessary to ensure compliance with the new 30-minute unencumbered time requirement,
- funding for the newly-opening Highland Springs Middle,
- an increase in funding for custodial supplies,
- increased State revenue for State Aid to Classrooms, Bus Driver Salaries, Retiree Insurance, and Tier 3/Act 388, and
- increased property tax revenue results from growth only with no tax increase.

The proposed budget totals \$248,982,727. Budgets for the Special Revenue Fund, EIA Fund, Debt Service Fund, and Capital Projects Fund are also presented for Board review.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the second/final reading of the 2023 – 2024 budget with any changes resulting from Board discussion.
