The Palmetto Fellows Scholarship is a merit-based program established in 1988 to recognize the most academically talented high school seniors and encourage these students to attend college in the State. The Palmetto Fellows Scholarship **Program** administered by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education. Palmetto Fellows may receive up to \$6,700 their freshman year and up to \$7,500 for their nore, junior and senior Half of the Scholarship is sophomore, awarded in the fall term and half in the spring term. The Scholarship must be applied directly toward the cost of attendance, less any other gift aid Assuming continued received. eligibility, Palmetto Fellows may receive Scholarship funding for a maximum of eight full-time terms of study toward their first bachelor's degree at an eligible four-year institution in South Carolina. The month of February was chosen to coincide with the birthdays of Frederick Douglass and Abraham Lincoln.

Walker, who was the first U.S. self-made millionaire; George who derived nearly 300 products from the peanut; Rosa the Montgomery **Bus Boycott and** galvanized the civil rights movement; and Shirley Chisholm, who was the first African American woman elected to the U.S. House of Representatives. For about five years or so she didn't speak to anyone about anything. During that time, she started to write poems and that is how she became a poet.




Who would you interview?

Dr. Curry's book, "The Thompson Family: Untold Stories of the Past (1830-1960)" is the first volume chronicling the family history of an African American family from Salley, South Carolina. Several narratives are featured, including a slave who purchased his freedom, a relative who served as a cook in the Confederate Army, a young relative who was tragically murdered, and a sharecropper who became a prominent soil conservationist. The book is the 2019 International African American Historical and Genealogical Society Book Award Winner.

# Aiken Innovate 2021-2022

Aiken County Public Schools is pleased to announce open enrollment for AIKEN iNNOVATE, the school district's fulltime virtual program, for students in grades 6-12, for the 2021-22 school year. The District believes face-to-face instruction is best for early learners; therefore, a full-time virtual program will not be offered for Kindergarten through fifth grade for the 2021-22 school year. Registration for AIKEN iNNOVATE is open today, Friday, February 5, 2021, and will continue until Monday, March, 1, 2021, through the District's online Parent Portal.To register, students must be enrolled in Aiken County Public Schools, and parents must have a Parent Portal account. The enrollment form is located under the FORMS tab on the left side of the Parent Portal home page. This registration period is for those who are certain they wish to participate in fulltime virtual programming, and staffing will be determined by the number of enrollments during this registration period. Parents who do not have a Parent Portal account should contact their home school. This information is based on the pandemic no longer being a serious concern when school begins in the fall. If during the summer it becomes apparent that schools will possibly operate on an altered schedule or with pandemic protocols in place, and/or if vaccines are not widely available for all age groups, registration will re-open for parents to select virtual programming. Additional details on AIKEN iNNOVATE open enrollment for the 2021-22 school year, including a course listing, will be provided in an email message today and be made available on our website.

Valentine's Day Dinner

Air Fryer Pork Chops (recipe found on Delish.com)

Note: if you don't have an air fryer – this works just as well baked in the oven.

### **INGREDIENTS**

4 boneless pork chops
2 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
1/2 c. freshly grated Parmesan
1 tsp. kosher salt
1 tsp. paprika
1 tsp. garlic powder
1 tsp. onion powder
1/2 tsp. freshly ground black pepper

### **DIRECTIONS**

1.Pat pork chops dry with paper towels, then coat both sides with oil. In a medium bowl, combine Parmesan and spices. Coat both sides of pork chops with Parmesan mixture.

- 2. Place pork chops in basket of air fryer and cook at 375° for 9 minutes, flipping halfway through. (I ended up cooking mine for about 12 minutes using a meat thermometer to make sure they were fully cooked.
- 3. Serve with rice and roasted mixed vegetables on the side.

**Add Ingredients:** 

1/2 cup semisweet chocolate chips

3 tablespoons heavy cream

12 long-stemmed strawberries

Melt the chocolate and cream together in a bowl set over simmering water until just melted. Stir and remove from the heat. Dip each strawberry in the chocolate and set aside on waxed or


