Remember finger foods will be available at prom. Make sure that you make reservations as you will not be the only school attending prom that night.


#### Flowers - Corsage, Boutonnieres, and Bouquets

Pizza Casserole

**Ingredients** 

4 cups penne pasta

1 pound ground beef

1/2 pound pork sausage

4 ounces pepperoni

1/2 green bell pepper, chopped

1 small onion, chopped

1/2 cup freshly grated parmesan cheese

1 teaspoon dried oregano leaves

2 cloves garlic, minced

1 can sliced mushrooms (optional)

1 small can sliced olives

24 ounce jar marinara pasta sauce (homemade pizza sauce\*)

1-2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese

**Instructions** 

Cook penne pasta according to package instructions. Drain and set aside.

Brown ground beef and sausage in a large skillet over medium heat. Remove grease.

Add cooked meat to a large mixing bowl. Add pepperoni, bell pepper, onion, parmesan cheese, oregano, garlic, mushroom and olives.

Add noodles and pasta sauce and toss to combine.

Pour mixture into a greased 9x13" pan.

Sprinkle 1-2 cups of mozzarella cheese on top, (depending on how much cheese you want).

Bake at 350 degrees F for 25-30 minutes or until cheese is melted and bubbling.

\*5-Minute Pizza Sauce

Make ahead instructions: Assemble the pizza casserole up until baking and store covered in the refrigerator for several hours. Remove from oven and bake as directed.


