COURSE DESCRIPTION



TURNING IN ASSIGNMENTS

Your signature must be in the lower right hand corner of each piece of artwork. Name your artwork on the right side of each piece. If you turn in someone else's work as your own you will receive a zero as well as the owner of the artwork. If someone else completes your assignment, you will both receive a zero. Once artwork is submitted and graded, it will be up for display on Artsonia. Parents and family members can see your artwork for each assignment. Please remind them to sign up for Artsonia in their email.

FIELD TRIPS

If you have below a "C" in any class, you are not permitted to attend an Art field Trip. Attendance and Discipline also prevent travel.

RESTROOM

Go to the restroom before class. No one is allowed to leave 15 minutes at the beginning of class and before the end of class. Only one student may go to the restroom at a time. You must use the restrooms in the cafeteria area.



Art fees for the class are \$10 and are due within the first 10 days of class.

CELL PHONE POLICY:
