April Minutes- Minutes accepted and approved. Motion made by Jonathan Keklak and seconded by Donna Edwards. All in attendance voted yes.

Treasurer's Report- Report discussed and accepted. Motion made to accept by Donna Edwards and seconded by Jonathan Keklak. All in attendance voted yes.

Concessions- The doors on at the Baseball and Football field concession stands have been fixed.

Hornet Hut- Hornet Hut sales of old inventory at the Freshman Orientation earned \$480.00. Jonathan Keklak announced he would be doing inventory this month and prepare to order new items. He is looking for ideas about possible items to order.

Ad Sales- A committee has been formed in preparation for start of ad sales over the summer. There is still question about how much of the sales can be claimed as donations by purchasing businesses.

Membership- New membership forms to be out in July or August and will be made available on line and via email to current members. Parking passes may be renewed when forms available. Parking pass renewals will have a deadline to be set at the next meeting. After the deadline passes, the available spaces that include those not renewed will be first come first serve.

Old Business- 13 total Scholarship packets were received. 2 were incomplete and considered disqualified. Students who were chosen will be notified at Awards Day. Will Mundy reported that he received complaints that students needed more time to complete the packets. He stated that the committee will consider this next year when setting deadlines for packets. He reported that many packets were missing things and that he called all of these students to give them an opportunity to add them to the packets. The biggest problem seemed to be that teachers were not turning in recommendation forms.
