Summer School Offerings at Midland Valley High School

APEX

Summer school will be offered through APEX virtual learning which allows students to take almost any history, English, math, or science credit for initial credit. This is a good option for students who failed a class with lower than a 50 for the year. Initial credit courses will receive the actual grade earned through completion.

* English 1, Algebra I, Biology I, and US History initial credit courses will require a state mandated EOC test which counts as 20% of the student's final grade.

APEX courses are not in compliance with NCAA.

Students should bring their lunch as lunch will not be provided.

Money orders and cashier's checks will be the only form of payment. Cash and personal checks will not be accepted.

Credit Recovery

Credit recovery is an opportunity for students who failed a core content class, to earn a "P" (passing) in place of their failing grade. Credit Recovery courses do not require EOC testing. Credit Recovery courses are not recognized by NCAA.

ACVA

ACVA is offering several courses this summer. **The student will need to create a student account on virtualsc.org and register online between May 15 and May 29.** Students will begin the course through virtualsc.org on June 17. ACVA courses are the only summer courses designed for the student to work at home.

Disclaimers

Initial credit courses will be assigned a certified teacher. All regular school rules will apply during summer school. If a student is removed from summer school due to behavior issues or non-attendance, a refund will not be granted. Class availability is based upon enrollment. Lack of enrollment will result in classes being cancelled.
